### Oil Painting Exotic Animals in the Wild with Barbara Jablonski

Create a natural atmospheric environment surrounding the painting of wild animals. Learn the skills of transferring the drawing into larger or focused compositions while combining

both traditional studio and plein air oil painting landscape techniques. This course is designed for artists who are experienced in studio oil painting. Using simple computer techniques and drawing transfer techniques, participants will learn how to create subjects that fit various standard canvas sizes. Instruction includes composition and design, value, temperature and color mixing, drawing, perspective, line and painting techniques to create life-like paintings. A step-by-step demonstration of a wild animal in its natural environment will be painted in oil pigment by the instructor. The painting subjects and photo reference will be provided. ### Gelli Plate Printmaking

Gelli Plates are reusable printing plates that let you create monoprints without a press. In these two classes we will explore a variety of techniques unique to the Gelli plate to create decorative paper. We'll use stencils, create textures, explore wax resists and more. You'll be encouraged to consider the importance of color and value while printing. This medium is fun and invites experimentation, expect plenty of time to play!

Suitable for beginners and a refresher for those with some experience in Gelli printing.

- You'll need to bring to the workshop:
   a soft rubber brayer (Speedball 2.5"-3")
- a Gelli Arts printing plate (8" x 10")
- · any special papers you'd like to print on.
- · an apron and something to drink.
